- Promoting emotional, psychological, and physical wellbeing for learners who have been historically marginalized.
- Removing barriers and providing accessible and empowering opportunities for students to learn and grow.

Nomination and Selection Process

Please submit a nomination package to the School Board Office (1383 Ninth Avenue, Kamloops BC V2C 3X7) no later than **April 25, 2025**. The package should contain:

- A completed nomination form;
- Three letters of reference/support, from sources other than the nominator and representing a broad range of interests;
- A description (2-page maximum) of how this individual has made the school environment better by: supporting growth of all learners, promoting emotional, psychological, and physical wellbeing for learners who have been historically marginalized, and removing barriers and providing accessible and empowering opportunities for students to learn and grow. The description also needs to include how the nominee is collaborative, enthusiastic, selfless, generous, and a positive risk taker.
- A biographical statement (1-page maximum) that enables the committee to learn about the professional and personal background of the nominee.

Based on the documentation, a panel will review nominations and make a recommendation to the Board of Education for the award recipient for the year.
