#### Prescribed Minimum Hours of Instruction

In accordance with the School Act, a Board of Education must offer not less than the following hours of instruction in a school year to students enrolled in the schools in its district:

- 853 hours of instruction for students in kindergarten;
- 878 hours of instruction for students in grades 1 to 7;
- 952 hours of instruction for students in grades 8 to 12.
