



A bursary has been established by the Frank Family in memory of their matriarch, Maureen Frank of Xwisten. Maureen valued family, bringing people together and education/ learning opportunities. A legacy in her name is to honor 3 Indigenous youth.

The selection of the award recipient will be based on a combination of factors. Guidelines and criteria for the Bursary Award are as follows:

- Applicants must be of Indigenous ancestry.
- Applicants must demonstrate an appreciation for Indigenous culture and language by:
 - showing that they regularly participate in Indigenous events and celebrations, **or**
 - writing a one-page essay on "What role Indigenous culture has played in my life".
- Applicants must demonstrate a financial need for the bursary assistance.
- Applicants must demonstrate that they have been involved in school and/or community service by describing the types of activities that they have helped with or participated in.

The amount of the award for 2022 is approximately \$500.

The award will be presented at School District 73 (Kamloops-Thompson) Aboriginal Graduation Ceremony.

NOTE: The funds in this award will be awarded, once you have been accepted into your Program and show proof of registration in your course.
