Scholarship Award Information and Application Form

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Applications for this award must be received on or before June 1, 2020. Late applications will not be considered.
2. Applicants must be a direct family member to a member of the Kamloops and District Woodlot Association. In cases where the woodlot is not owned by an individual, one applicant per woodlot is eligible to apply in any given year.
3. Applicants must be planning to attend a post secondary institution including a trades school within 24 months of the application deadline.
4. Preference will be given to relatives of those members who are woodlot licensee holders in the Kamloops or Merritt TSA's.
5. **Up to two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to the top two ranked applications.** Depending on demand, and discretion of the Award Committee, each \$1000 allocation may be split into two \$500 scholarships.
6. The awards will be payable on receipt by the KDWA of documentation confirming registration into the institution for post secondary education. This generally occurs at the end of September. Payment will be made in two instalments with the second instalment given out after proof of going on in the second semester.
7. The decision of the Awards Committee is final.
8. The Award Committee of the Kamloops and District Woodlot Association will be empowered to:
 - a) grant this award at its discretion;
 - b) withhold this award in any year if there are no eligible applicants, or for any reason deemed good or advisable.

IMPORTANT

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Please complete the application form and attach:

1. Applicants must submit proof of academic record and a brief description (up to 500 words) of how he or she meets the criteria and why the Board should choose them for this award. Applicants should also submit a brief resume outlining their interests, extracurricular activities, job experience, and school marks.
2. Two letters of reference required - one from the school (principal or teacher preferred) plus another (employer, coach, community member, etc) to accompany the application.
